This resolution memorializes the THA Board of Commissioners' apology to John Hall for his experience during THA's 2021 Executive Director search.

Background

On October 8, 2021, the THA Board of Commissioners voted to appoint April Black as THA's next Executive Director. This appointment was made after the Board voted to vacate a previous vote that extended an offer for the Executive Director position to John Hall.

In October 2021, the Board of Commissioners recognized, through a press release, that:

The Executive Director selection process suffered from an initial lack of inclusion and provoked conflict. Some of the comments received exposed both final candidates to rancorous and personal attacks that were unnecessary and inappropriate. The Board of Commissioners regrets and apologizes to the final candidates for subjecting them to this painful and undignified flurry of divisive remarks.

This resolution will offer the following more detailed apology to Mr. Hall:

The Board of Commissioners recognizes that the 2021 Executive Director selection process unnecessarily provoked conflict. We initially voted to offer the position to John Hall. We later received comments on the process and the candidates. Some of the comments received exposed John Hall to rancorous and personal attacks that were inappropriate, distorted, and damaging to his reputation. The Board of Commissioners regrets and apologizes to Mr. Hall for subjecting him to this painful and undignified flurry of divisive remarks.
